Home Learning Missions

- Research interesting facts about Mexico/Wales, for example - where is it, what is the population, what is Mexico/Wales famous for?
- Find out about Mexico/Wales —which part would you like to visit and why?
- Recreate the Mexican/Wales flag using arts and crafts.
- In Mexico, the most common spoken language is Spanish. Find out how to say some phrases in Spanish. Create a poster to teach others.
- What special celebrations/festivals do Mexican people celebrate? Design a two-page spread to share what you have found out.
- Alphabet challenge! Find the name of a Welsh band for each letter of the alphabet. Listen to their music. Which is your favourite Welsh band? Why?

- Choose 10 words in Welsh about Wales to make a word picture on wordart.com.

- Make a typical Mexican or Welsh dish, such as guacamole, Welsh cakes or tacos. Serve it to your family and get them to review it. Take some photos of your creation to show me.
- Design your own 'Day of the Dead' mask.
- Find out about Mexican flowers, trees or animals. Some are very different to those found in the UK!
- Make a musical instrument for a Welsh/Mexican festival – simple drums, guitars, shakers – from everyday household objects, like plastic bottles, elastic bands, and rice.
- Make a loaf of Bread of the Dead. Bring some in for me to taste, or a photo!
- Create a fact file about Frida Kahlo
- Research famous people who have come from Mexico/Wales and tell me why they are famous.

- Compose a poem, each line beginning with the letters of DEWI SANT.
- Make a fact file about Dewi Sant.

- Collect and decorate stones with Welsh words and pictures of Welsh emblems. Make a mosaic.
