BREAKFAST CLUB for Reception – Y6 From September 14th 2020

Dear Parents/Carers,

As agreed by our Governing Body we are writing to advise you that we are now in a position to re-open our Breakfast Club facility but in the short term, with reduced numbers following our risk assessment. **ALL PLACES will need to be booked in advance as we need to control numbers. Please click on the link below which will take you to a bookable form to secure your place. Presently we will accept bookings on a first come, first served basis.**

Both Breakfast Clubs will open from **Monday 14th September 2020**

Early Bird 7.50am – until 8.20am

We will be able to accept **15** children each day as agreed by our Governing Body. The prices of Early Bird remain unchanged. **However, places must be booked in advance up until HALF TERM and payment for the ENTIRE period can be made via sQuid.** (Mrs. Beynon will confirm your place and set this up for you) alternatively you can send in a cheque.



Welsh Government Free Breakfast will be open from 8.20am – 8.40am

Each day we will accept **15** children, as agreed by our Governing Body. **Please note that if you have NOT booked you CANNOT just turn up.**



Where will breakfast club take place?

The setting of our school hall will be used as before, but children will be grouped and seated as per their class (siblings will also sit with their class). Breakfast will be served directly to their table and will consist of toast and fruit.

The prices are as follows:

Children in Reception to Year 6

- Book in advance for next half term and pay £36.00 per child. This guarantees you a place every day. (This is equivalent to paying £1.20 per day.)
- Book in advance for two or more sessions a week and you pay £1.50 per child per session.
- Book in advance one off day is £2.00 per child per session.

ENTRY into breakfast

Access into the Breakfast Club will be as before, through the Rugby Club Gate and via the ramp. Please ring the bell and a member of staff will be expecting you. Please note that the last **FREE breakfast** will be served at 8.30am. Please then exit the building via the one way system and out of the green side gate.

Depending on the review of our risk assessment, and demand of Early Bird and Free Government Breakfast we will **consider** increasing numbers and offering this provision to older Nursery children. **However, please bear in mind that ideally breakfast at home is preferable!**
