



## Penclawdd Primary School TTP information sheet

### Staying away from school

**Do not attend school and self-isolate if you or your child:**

- Has any symptoms of Coronavirus (self-isolate for 10 days)
- Live in a household with a person who has tested positive for Coronavirus (self-isolate for 14 days)
- Have been contacted by a contact tracer and told that you must self-isolate (self-isolate for 14 days)

**Arrange a test for anyone who has any of the following symptoms by going to [www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test](http://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test) or dialing the free number 119:**

- New continuous cough
- High temperature (above 37.8oC)
- Reduced taste or smell (anosmia)

***If your child has symptoms and you are waiting for their test results, they must not attend school and must self-isolate.***

***If your child is a contact of a case, they must self-isolate for the full 14 days even if they have a negative test result.***

**To minimise the transmission of COVID 19 the school community must adhere to the following guidance:**

- Staff, learners and parents/carers must fully understand that any staff member or learner who has possible symptoms of COVID-19 must not attend the school setting



but must remain home and self-isolate, arrange a COVID-19 test and notify the school of this.

- Any family/household member of any member of staff member or learner who displays possible symptoms of COVID-19 then the staff member or learner must not attend the school setting but must remain at home and commence a period of household isolation. The school should be notified of this.
- Where a staff member or learner becomes unwell at the school with possible symptoms of COVID-19 they will be sent home immediately where they should self-isolate and arrange a COVID-19 test. Until they leave the school setting (in the case of a learner waiting to be collected by a parent/carer) their contact with all other individuals at the setting should be minimised. If possible, we will ensure they remain in a separate room until they are able to leave the setting. **All such incidents MUST be reported to the head teacher, or the deputy head teacher in her absence.**
